




## About 1822—James Lake, Jr.'s left leg amputated


"While clearing land for a home and crops, he (James Lake, Jr.) accidentally struck his left shin with the ax, tearing the flesh and splintering the bone. With each beat of his heart the blood gushed from the wound. All his wife's efforts to stop the flow of blood were futile. It appeared that he could not survive, when suddenly a handsome, gray haired gentleman came into the room. 'How do you do, my good friend. You seem to be in trouble,' he said. 'Yes, it looks as though my moments in this life are numbered.' James answered. The old gentleman took from his pocket a small bottle and handed it to James. 'Just apply this and the bleeding will stop.' He then turned and walked out of the room. James called his wife, saying, 'Follow that man quickly and see where he is going.' She hurried to the door but could not see the man anywhere. James' leg stopped bleeding with the first application of the medicine."<sup>37</sup> (p. 569) James stopped bleeding with the first application of the medicine. After he (James) joined the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints and read about the three Nephites in the Book of Mormon, he was convinced that the white haired gentleman who saved his life was one of them."<sup>37</sup> (p. 569) James Lake, Jr.'s life was spared but his left leg had to be amputated. 
