On the 16 day of January ¹⁸⁹⁸ closed her eyes in death and her spirit took its flight to heaven to mingle with the rich ones. At the time of her death we were at Monticello stopping with Bp Jones. The people there were very kind to us and did all they could for us. She was dressed in her Temple robes and layed in her coffin and on Monday 17th at 3 P. M. we started for home and for five days Snow and I drove before reaching home Sunday Jan 23 1898.

Funeral service over the remains of sister Clara, Johnston. Young were held at 2 P. M. in the meeting house. Bp James B. Ashcroft, Presiding.

Choir sang. O God is love.

Elder Ira Hatch, offered a short but touching prayer. Choir sang. The Resurrection Hymn.

Elder Hans. Bayless of Bluff Utah, and Elders A. C. Burnham, Wm. H. Black, and Bp Ashcroft gave instructions and consoling remarks, after which twelve vehicles followed the remains to the Fruitland Cemetery - the Vicatory Prayer was offered by first bornster Wm. C. Black. The day was very cold, causing the ceremonies to be somewhat short brief. The departed was the wife of Elder Samuel C. Young. They had just visited the Monticello Temple, and received their blessings and seating. She died at Monticello while on their way home. Brother Young had the sympathy of the entire community.

 upon you. Hear brother Samuel be very
 humble and obedient like a child and thy guardians
 angle shall watch over you and warn you of danger.
 Thy faith shall increase and the spirit of prophecy
 shall rest upon you. The breastplate in its fullness
 shall be restored to you in the own due time of the Lord
 Thou shall be a fisher and a hunter even a fisher
 of men. Thou shall run and not be weary and
 walk and not get tired, knock and it shall be
 opened unto you. If you desire it in your heart
 thou shall have visions and dreams and your eyes
 shall be opened you shall see in the future to describe

and the glorious kingdom of the Lord Jesus Christ shall be revealed unto you. Can you think of any good thing in the heavens or in the earth that shall not be in your reach according to your faithfulness. Dear brother do not forget your secret prayers for that is the key to the fathers heart. I seal you up to eternal life and to come fourth in the morning of the first resurrection and receive all the glory and power you prepare your self for. This I seal upon you and all your former blessings by authority of the Holy priesthood in the name of Jesus Christ, Amen.

A Patriarchal blessing by L. C. Burnham on the head of Samuel C. Young born 24 April 1877 at Orderville Kane Co Utah.

Thou shalt labor for the cause of Zion for the bringing to pass of righteousness. Thy joy shall be full for thou shalt have a fullness of joy. For many shall arise and call thee blessed. Thy posterity shall be numerous and thou shalt rejoice in thy seed, and the Lord is with thee and he will be with thee and protect thee from all the snares of the adversary for thou shalt have

power with the heavens and overcome every opposition
whether seen or unseen, and because of the love of God
for your progenitors the Lord will bless thee for ever.
Thou shalt have houses and lands and all the natural
things that will be for your comfort and blessing.
Thou shalt be blessed in thy basket and in thy store
and all the blessing that thy heart desirest in rightness
I seal upon thee in the name of Jesus Christ Amen.

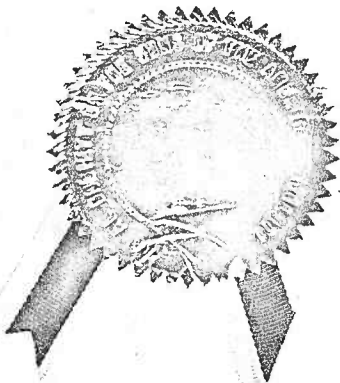
