There are about 36 pictures in this collection.

In the early 1980s Carol said that her husband, Legrand, was capable of putting slides onto the TV. Ron's family took her up on that and gave her some slides and 8mm movie reels. In November a square package arrived from Cedar City. It was assumed to be a Christmas present. It was the slides and movies, plus a VHS tape with all those things on it.

These days (2020) the VHS tape has been digitized. Ron used the digitized form to cull pictures from the tape.

The pictures from the slides have been given file names, or titles. The titles do not show on the pictures themselves in this "pdf" book.

The reader is encouraged to add his guess, and that will eventually help to identify the picture.

The pictures are generally fuzzy, or "low definition". This is due to three things:

- 1- TV and VHS resolution is only 40% of what a computer typically shows.
- 2- Frame grabbing that Ron did degraded the resolution by another 30%.
- 3- Some of the pictures were somewhat fuzzy to begin with.

Therefore, the original slides or pictures (and movies) will give much better quality. Don't expect to see much detail here.
